## Practice Safe Shopping!

Ah, online shopping... it's all fun and games unless it's a scam, so if you can't resist that \*perfect\* piece, at least use some basic precautions to make sure you get it!

- Look for https: sites with the lock symbol
- Only give necessary information
- Create strong passwords
- Use a credit card or PayPal
- Check your card statements regularly
- Stay updated against malware and phishing
- Use private Wi-Fi networks
- Be cautious of snoopers when on your laptop in public
- Use retailers' apps to shop directly
- Use your smartphone's mobile payment app
- Verify the seller is authentic
- You know what they say about "too good to be true"!
